There were two Memorial Day events- 1. A discussion by Lassen Forest supervisor Jerry Bird about newer rules regarding vehicles on Forest Service land. 2. A slide show about life along the Humboldt Road.

There was a potluck dinner at the Jonesville snow mobile park attended by numerous local residents. The food was delicious.

Our History Museum was more completely furnished and decorated thanks to the efforts of Carolyn Clayton and BK Brooks.

Two beautiful quilts were created by a group of local residents. One quilt was donated to the Jonesville Hotel restoration group for sale at their fundraiser and the other quilt is to be raffled off today.

Current members of the BMJCA board of directors were introduced. It was announced that Steve Miller and Tom Arcoleo are leaving the board. The nomination committee recommended that Betty Volker and Stu Thompson be appointed to the board. There is still one vacancy on the board. Steve Miller made the motion that Betty and Stu be appointed to the board. The motion was seconded by Dave DeBock. Betty and Stu were elected unanimously by the general membership.
